

Where to stay



Maybourne Beverly Hills

Guests can choose ocean-view rooms with private balconies or expansive suites, and enjoy the Guerlain Wellness Spa's sauna, steam, and plunge pools, along with Mediterranean-inspired dining at Orla by Michael Mina.

9882 S Santa Monica Boulevard, Beverly Hills, CA 90212



Hotel Bel-Air

701 Stone Canyon Road, Los Angeles, CA 90077

This serene landmark is the only hotel permitted in the exclusive enclave of Bel-Air. The building was originally established as offices and stables (the pool is a former horse-riding ring) but was reconceived as a verdant oasis in the 1940s. Its ultra-private suites make it popular with couples and celebrities alike - the romantic Swan Lake suite, with butterflies painted across the bedroom walls, is our favorite.



1 Hotel West Hollywood

Nestled at the bottom of the Hollywood Hills, 1 Hotel is a calm and relaxing sanctuary in the heart of the city. Sustainability and a connection to nature takes center stage here, from the use of native greenery, reclaimed wood beams, clay tones and natural fabrics, to a ban on single-use plastics. The chef's organic rooftop garden is resplendent with fruits and vegetables and guarantees delicious and fresh California inspired dishes at the hotel's 3 restaurants and bars.



Ritz-Carlton Downtown LA

900 W Olympic Blvd, Los Angeles, CA 90015

Situated at L.A. Live in downtown, The Ritz-Carlton combines modern luxury with prime access to the city's entertainment district. Guestrooms feature floor-to-ceiling windows with sweeping views, while the Club Level offers personalized service and curated dining. A rooftop pool and spa add a resort-like touch, all just steps from the Crypto.com Arena, theaters, and a dynamic culinary scene.



The Proper Hotel, Santa Monica

Where to eat



Mother Wolf

1545 Wilcox Ave, Los Angeles, CA 90028

This hot spot from Evan Funke, the pasta king behind Felix Trattoria and Funke, is an homage to the Eternal city, serving rich and soulful classics. Enjoy wild mushroom pizza, oxtail meatballs, and an extensive Italian wine selection in the sprawling dining room. The restaurant offers a Hollywood party vibe - perfect for late-night entertaining over a smoothly seductive Negroni blanco cocktail.



Alba

8451 Melrose Ave, West Hollywood, CA 90069

Inspired by their travels, the ALBA team created the idea of Holiday Italian, capturing the essence of Italy's charm and sophistication; the warmth of its people, the allure of its style, and the timeless joy of its way of life. Here, cosmopolitan style meets coastal vibrancy, a celebration of life's beauty in its simplest, most indulgent form.



Polo Lounge

9641 Sunset Boulevard, Beverly Hills, CA 9021

If that candy-striped ceiling could talk... There is a century-long history here of seeing and being seen, especially among Hollywood's powerbrokers at the Polo Lounge. There are three dining areas, though the patio is especially pretty. Order the McCarthy Salad, which is assembled tableside.



Craig's

8826 Melrose Avenue, West Hollywood, CA 90069

Craig's has been described as the hottest restaurant in Hollywood, and it's easy to see why. Paparazzi wait at the door for A-listers, agents, and other industry power players to cross the threshold. Expect upscale comfort food with a sizable list of vegan options. The chicken parmigiana is so beloved, it has its own line of merchandise.



Drake's

8747 Melrose Ave, West Hollywood, CA 90069

Located on the iconic Melrose Avenue, a trip to Drake's is like stepping back in time - the interior is dimly lit with rich leather booths, warm wood paneling, a fully stocked bar and vintage Hollywood inspired art. The menu offers elevated twists on American classics. Standouts include a truffled filet mignon cracker-crust pizza, and their trademark 'World's Coldest Martini.'

Steak 48

9680 Wilshire Blvd, Beverly Hills, CA 90212

The luxurious Steak 48 is led by Mastro's founders Jeff and Michael Mastro. The restaurant is sleek and modern, with an open kitchen. The sustainably sourced steaks and premium Wagyu beef from the Mishima Reserve are wet-aged for 28 days and cooked in an 1800-degree broiler. The kitchen also offers quality seafood such as Alaskan king crab, Maine lobster, and freshly shucked oysters.



Nobu Malibu

22706 Pacific Coast Hwy, Malibu, CA 90265

Known for its exquisite food, glossy service, and glistening ocean views, Nobu Malibu is the most popular reservation in town. Once you're in, prepare to be dazzled. Dishes are simple but glorious, served with a side of serious celeb-spotting. The Chilean seabass is phenomenal, and each morsel of Nobu's famous miso black cod is more luxurious and delicious than the last.



Saltie Girl

8615 Sunset Blvd, West Hollywood, CA 90069

Inspired by founder Kathy Sidell's New England upbringing and passion for the sea, Saltie Girl focuses on fresh and sustainable fish and seafood - be it fried, sautéed, raw, house-potted, or smoked. Signature dishes include the fried lobster and waffle with sweet corn butter, and the Saltie Girl lobster roll, served warm or cold with house-made salt and vinegar potato chips. Watching the chefs preparing crudo and raw oysters in action at the cold appetizer station is a highlight.



Casa Madera

8440 Sunset Blvd, West Hollywood, CA 90069

This cool, Tulum-inspired Mexican hang-out in The Mondrian Hotel offers up bold flavors and hard-to-beat views. The menu is influenced by Mexico's beach towns - the Duck Carnitas Tacos, and Torre de Mariscos, overflowing with oysters, mussels, and jumbo shrimp, are some of the many top picks.



MUSE – Santa Monica

1541 Ocean Ave, Santa Monica, CA 90401

A coastal-chic newcomer with a contemporary edge, MUSE blends California freshness with global inspiration. The menu highlights seasonal seafood and inventive small plates, while the sleek dining room and oceanfront address make it a stylish pick for Santa Monica nights. Ideal for both intimate dinners and buzzy weekend celebrations.



Coucou

218 Main St, Venice, CA 90291

On the border of Venice and Santa Monica, Coucou is a chic and buzzy cocktail bistro which celebrates aperitif culture and the timeless bistros of France. Expect traditional French fare paired with Coastal California produce, prepared over a live-fire grill. Begin with a classic Aperol Spritz, and tuck into French favorites of mussels mariniere and pommes frites - the vibe here is cool, cozy, and delicious.



Giorgio Baldi

114 W Channel Rd, Santa Monica, CA 90402

An LA staple of over 30 years, this quiet and unassuming high-end Italian is in fact a celebrity hideout like no other - Rihanna is said to eat here every day when she is in town. The menu here is traditional and expensive but worth it - try the Risotto with roasted peppers and Dungeness crab, or the Sweet Corn Agnolotti with mascarpone and truffle butter.

Tower Bar

8358 Sunset Blvd, West Hollywood, CA 90069

This old Hollywood classic spot is a haven for a discerning crowd. Low lighting, cozy booths, and a live jazz pianist add to the timeless feel. Nab a table on the outdoor terrace with views of Sunset Boulevard, and tuck into tuna tartare, crab cakes and caviar. The build-your-own sundae for dessert is a fun must-try.



Elephante

18412 Pacific Coast Highway, Santa Monica

The buzzing rooftop restaurant from designer and restaurateur Nicholas Mathers aims to transport guests from Los Angeles to the Southern Mediterranean and has panoramic views to prove it. Come for the expertly crafted cocktails, curated list of natural wines, and coastal Italian bites.

A DTLA institution, Bestia is an industrial-chic temple to Italian dining. Handmade pastas, house-cured salumi, and wood-fired pizzas anchor the menu, with an exceptional wine list to match. Expect a vibrant, warehouse-style setting packed with locals and insiders alike.



Girl & The Goat

555-3 Mateo St, Los Angeles, CA 90013

Stephanie Izard brings bold, globally inspired flavors to the Arts District. Small plates like wood-grilled oysters and goat curry keep the energy high, while the lively open dining room and cocktail program make it a go-to for group dinners and late-night buzz.



BAVEL

500 Mateo Street, Los Angeles, CA 90013

This modern Middle Eastern is both a celebration of classics and innovative twists on traditional fare. So good you'll probably over-order. The must-try list is long, but make time for the hummus, the grilled oyster mushrooms, and the lamb neck shawarma.



Manuela

907 E 3rd St, Los Angeles, CA 90013

Located within Hauser & Wirth's arts complex, Manuela blends California produce with Southern flair. Think buttermilk biscuits, farm-fresh vegetables, and inventive cocktails served amid rotating contemporary art.



Death&Co DTLA

818 E 3rd St, Los Angeles, CA 90013

The famed New York cocktail institution's West Coast outpost, Death & Co. DTLA delivers moody elegance and a next-level bar program, every sip is an experience. Ideal for those seeking a refined, after-dark hideaway.



Perch (Rooftop)

448 S Hill St, Los Angeles, CA 90013

This French-inspired rooftop bistro pairs sweeping skyline views with classic cocktails and bistro fare. With lush greenery, live music, and a see-and-be-seen crowd, Perch is the quintessential DTLA rooftop for sunset drinks or late-night ambience.



You'll know it best for Chris Burden's 'Urban Light' installation of streetlamps at the main entrance, but LACMA's vast permanent collection spans 6,000 years of art history. The temporary exhibitions are always engaging too.
